Note to B.C. Candidates

The B.C. candidates who are claiming B.C. reservation in the State Government Employment vide G.O. Ms. No. 3, Backward Classes Welfare (C2) Department dated 04/04/2006 should invariably produce the Creamy Layer Certificate in the above proforma to the APPSC to grant B.C. reservation in any recruitment.

N.B.: OBC Creamy Layer Certificate is meant for the use of Central Government Employment only. It is not acceptable to State Government Employment as there is variation in the income limits including format. Therefore, the candidates who produce OBC certificates can not be granted B.C. Reservation.
